Jazmine's Story: A Safe Start for Her Family

When Jazmine moved to the U.S., she was eager to create a safe and nurturing home for her baby daughter, Leila. Referred by South Coast Global Medical Center, she joined the Infant and Toddler Home Visitation Program—and found more than just parenting classes.

Since enrolling in February, Jazmine has attended every session with care and curiosity. She's learned how to keep her baby safe at home and outdoors, strengthened her bond with her daughter, and gained confidence in her parenting. Through personalized support, she was also connected to vital services—like Medi-Cal, her pediatrician's office, and community resource centers.



Her family received essentials including diapers, wipes, a safe crib, a highchair, and even gift cards to help furnish her home and care for her older daughters. What began as a desire to learn new parenting strategies has grown into a story of resilience, advocacy, and love.

“Jazmine shows up every time. She asks thoughtful questions and stays curious. She’s not only growing as a parent—she’s becoming a strong advocate for her children.”

She’s not alone—88% of families surveyed in our Orange County Infant-Toddler Home Visitation Program reported learning about new resources for their child and family.

Jazmine's story is one of many that show how early support and community-based care can prevent crises and help families thrive.
